Grant Cooper and his crew from **Rejuvenate Construction Solutions** are quickly getting the framing and pitched rafter structure (to match the original building) in place. The main framing will be finished this week (26 Nov) and a new roof will be in place by December. (*A great deal from **Stramit Roofing** allows us to afford an entire new roof for the building.*)
