The dirt road in foreground was not paved until the 1960s, hence, the Railway was the main transportation system with staff manning the station 24hrs/7days. In this era, there were dances almost every weekend at the Hall. Doug Groundwater remembers once counting five steam trains waiting for the Mail Train to come through Gundiah. "All the stokers were in the Pub having a quick beer," he said.
